He is Senior Manager for Global Restoration Policy at the World Resources Institute (WRI). He leads the Initiative 20x20, a regional platform that supports ecosystem restoration in Latin America as part of the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration. He also coordinates the Landscape Policy Acceleration Program, which focuses on developing public economic incentives for restoration at the national level.

He holds a PhD in Forest Engineering and Economics from Oregon State University, where he studied the economic optimization of forest biomass processing and transport. In 2019, he received the Outstanding Doctoral Research Award from the International Union of Forest Research Organizations (IUFRO). He also holds a Master of Science in Forest Resources from the Austral University of Chile and a degree in Forest Engineering from Del Valle University of Guatemala, both awarded with academic distinction.



His work focuses on forest economics, public policy, investment mechanisms, and landscape monitoring. He has published more than 30 scientific articles on these topics.
